

## **CV Summary Dr. Marielle Blake**



Dr. Blake graduated from the University of Dublin, Trinity College in 1985. Following successful completion of her FDS she was accepted onto the Orthodontic training program at the University of Toronto graduating in 1992. Following her time in Toronto Dr. Blake moved to the UK where she worked as an orthodontic registrar in Guildford. She then completed her Senior Registrar training in Dublin. Dr. Blake is currently a consultant Orthodontist based in St. James's Hospital in Dublin. She has a teaching commitment in the Dublin Dental School and also maintains a private practice in Dublin in Orthodontics.

Dr. Blake is a Board Member of the Faculty of Dentistry RCSI and chaired the Education Committee from 2006 – 2008. She is currently Chair of the Examination sub-committee.

Dr. Blake is a member of the Dental Council of Ireland and is also a Board Member of the Dublin Dental Hospital.

### **Orthodontics in the mixed dentition**

This presentation gives an overview of the assessment of the young dental patient in a general dental practice setting. Early identification of orthodontic problems and appropriate action can reduce the complexity of future orthodontic treatment or in fact eliminate the need for orthodontic intervention.

### **Multidisciplinary management of the complex orthodontic problem**

Orthodontic patients often present with complex problems which require input from several other dental disciplines. This presentation will give an overview of the types of complex cases requiring multidisciplinary care. The multidisciplinary team members include the general dentist, orthodontist, periodontist, oral surgeon, maxillofacial surgeon, restorative dentist and the paediatric dentist.
