

On-Campus Safety Measures for Food Outlets

- All workers shall conduct Covid-19 testing prior to opening. Results must be submitted to the Office of Facilities and Services.
- Temperature checks are required prior to entry. Any person with a temperature higher than 37.5°C will not be permitted entry.
- Wearing face masks and gloves while on duty is mandatory at all times.
- A minimum 2 meters of social distance from others must be maintained at all times.
- Exercise good personal hygiene habits by regularly washing hands before and after food preparation, surface/utensil cleaning, and after handling waste.
- Use the designated entry and exit points for each building.
- Use disposable food service items (e.g., utensils, dishes, napkins, tablecloths).
- Avoid staff group gatherings inside the food outlet.
- Ensure a maximum capacity of 3 customers at the counter, and avoid queues in the waiting area.

- Accept non-cash/ card payment methods only.
- Avoid open food displays, and follow foodsafety measures to avoid crosscontamination.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces like countertops, condiment areas, food preparation surfaces, etc.
- Monitor staff daily for any Covid-19 like symptoms.
- Ensure that raw material delivery into the campus follows proper food safety procedures, and request proof that all drivers are Covid-19 infection-free.
- General directives of the UAE government related to restaurant/ food outlet protocols, Covid-19 testing, contact tracing, and isolation periods shall be strictly followed.
- If any workers feel unwell or experience Covid-19 like symptoms while on duty, s/he must contact the Office of Medical Services immediately for consultation or medical advice.
