



On-Campus Safety Measures for Students

- All students; whether vaccinated or not, shall conduct a Covid-19 test prior to the beginning of the semester, after coming back from vacations, and at regular intervals according to vaccination status.
- Vaccination is compulsory from 16 years of age or older to enter campus. An official certificate of exemption from vaccination is required for non-vaccinated individuals.
- Students need to conduct PCR tests regularly as required by the competent authorities and announced separately.
- Temperature checks are required prior to entry. Persons with a temperature higher than 37.5°C will not be permitted entry.
- Wearing face masks while on-campus is mandatory at all times.
- A minimum of 1 meter of social distance must be maintained at all times.
- Exercise good personal hygiene habits by regularly washing hands and using the hand sanitizers installed throughout the campus.
- Use the designated entry and exit points for each building.
- Follow the safety signage posted throughout the campus.
- Group gatherings, activities, or public events are not allowed on campus.
- Sport activities shall remain suspended until further notice.
- Use disposable prayer mats that are available at the mosque and follow the applicable safety measures while praying. Mosque will be open for students only.
- Stay at home if you feel unwell or experience flu-like symptoms.
- Avoid exchanging personal belongings, food items, stationaries, consumables, and medical instruments. Disinfect your items regularly.
- Bring your own prayer mat and follow the safety measures while in the mosque.
- Exchange of cash is not allowed across the campus. Only online payments, deposits, transfers, or card payments are accepted.
- Follow the posted precautionary measures while using the library, food court, common areas, labs, and clinics.
- Follow the seating stickers inside classrooms, labs, studios, clinics and all other facilities – and do not attempt to alter the seating arrangement.
- General directives of the UAE government related to Covid-19 testing, contact tracing, and isolation periods shall be followed.

- Student hostels shall be open for vaccinated students only.
- Transportation services will continue to cover the same destinations while maintaining social distancing and other applicable safety measures.
- Food can be consumed at the food court only. Food outlets will be open with strict safety measures. Card payments will be only accepted, and student gathering at the food court is not allowed.
- Any violations of the safety measures will be subject to disciplinary action according to applicable policies and procedures.
