The Humanities and Social Sciences Research Center (HSSRC) aims to organize major research projects and study important societal issues within the Emirati society and other cultural groups globally. Moreover, it strengthens research culture in humanities and social sciences that are related to community studies such as case studies and field studies in UAE society and that will contribute to educational and language studies. It may give researchers the ability to reach other professionals in government, non-profit organizations, shareholders, and the public to make research contributions to these fields easily accessible to address regional and global concerns today.

HSSRC OVERVIEW

The launching of HSSRC proves the particular Ajman University's dedication to the humanities and social sciences. Through the Deanship of Research and Graduate Studies, and now through the Research Center, AU has never ceased to promote research and to provide all the structural conditions to reinforce the capacity building of the researchers.

The Center focuses efforts and concerns towards research on current issues at the local, regional and international levels, in a manner that is both rooted in reality and keen on the future. The Center's research groups run from one to two years or more and researchers seek to amass scientific accumulation through research activities, writing and publication.

The research at the Center also relies on networking and collaboration with counterparts from high-ranked universities in the world as well as on multidisciplinary studies as currently required by complex societies to probe their transformations in depth and to focus on future foresight.

HSSRC is expected to have a significant social impact on the local society. To achieve this objective, HSSRC is focusing on partnerships with local institutions in two major perspectives which are applied research and training.

The main areas of HSSRC are sociology, sociology of the family, demography of Arab countries, psychology, social work, anthropology of contemporary societies, Education, Law, institutions and Society. Through these areas, the research groups seek answers to problematic and crucial questions such as the challenges of globalization, the problems of violence and crimes, family disintegration, immigration, the crisis of the value system, the impact of Information and Communications Technology on social dynamics and on the society at large, etc.

Such problematics are at the cutting edge of research, but they can also and above all prove necessary in other, more concrete areas. Indeed, Human Sciences, and in particular Social Sciences, have the vocation of examining the interactions between individuals and their societies. As a result, social and anthropological knowledge allows, for example a brand to better understand the needs of their customers through applied anthropology in UX/UI design, a town hall to build and promote new infrastructures that meet the demands of its citizens through sociological data, a law firm to be more sensitive to local rights, a hospital can offer ancillary medical services and respect/promote traditional medicine in the area, a development project to be more effective by taking into account the know-how of local inhabitants, or museums, educational and cultural institutions to offer relevant activities adapted to their public while expanding the latter.

Given the enormity of the difficulties and issues now confronting contemporary societies, the demand for social and human sciences is greater than ever. Moreover, these sciences carry big bets, foremost of which is the formation of a generation of intellectual immunity and critical skills.

AWARDS


