Admission Requirements

Admission Requirements for Bachelor’s Programs

- Admission to the Architecture program requires a UAE Secondary School Certificate (65% Elite / 70% Advanced / 80% General) or equivalent.
- Admission to Interior Design requires a UAE Secondary School Certificate (60% Elite / Advanced / General) or equivalent.
- EmSAT in English Language with a score of 1100 or an equivalent English Proficiency Test approved by MOE.

Admission Requirements for Master’s Programs

- Admission to the Master of Science in Urban Design requires a Bachelor’s degree in architecture or equivalent with a minimum undergraduate CGPA of 3.0 on a scale of 4 or equivalent, an EmSAT in English Language with a score of 1400 or an equivalent English Proficiency Test approved by MOE, and two letters of recommendation to be sent by appropriate academic referees before the student can be considered for the program.
