Admission Requirements

Admission Requirements for Bachelor's Programs

- A UAE Secondary School Certificate (70% Elite / 70% Advanced / 75% General)
 or equivalent.
- EmSAT in English Language with a score of 1100 or an equivalent English Proficiency Test approved by MOE.
- EmSAT in Arabic Language with a score of 600.
- EmSAT in Mathematics with a score of 600 or equivalent.
- Passing a personal interview conducted by the College of Business Administration.

Admission Requirements for Master's Programs (MBA)

- A Bachelor's degree, with a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 out of 4.0 or equivalent. (GPAs under 3.0 may be admitted on a conditional admission basis)
- EmSAT in English Language with a score of 1400 or an equivalent English Proficiency Test approved by MOE.
- Two recommendation letters from professionals who have taught the applicant in the graduate program.

Admission Requirements for Doctor of Business Administration (DBA)

- A Master's degree, with a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 out of 4.0 or equivalent.
- EmSAT in English Language with a score of 1400 or an equivalent English Proficiency Test approved by MOE.
- Passing a personal interview conducted by the College of Business Administration.
- Two recommendation letters from professionals who have taught the applicant in the graduate program.
- Work experience of at least two years in middle or senior management levels
